Reasons for Making the Call in

The call in is made solely in respect of the proposal for the reduction of the A1168 at the M11 junction. The scheme is mis-stated to be in Epping; it is in fact in Loughton and Chigwell. The scheme is proposed because of multiple collisions on the A1168 caused by vehicles which have left the M11 proceeding towards Chigwell tailing back from the gap in the central reservation of the A1168 and being collided with by other vehicles in the outer lane of the A1168 towards Loughton.

The three members representing Divisions in Chigwell and Loughton have agreed on the present call-in.

- 1. We appreciate safety measures may be needed at this inadequate/outdated junction, but we believe singling the A1168 will lead to unnecessary congestion for the heavy local traffic proceeding from Chigwell to Loughton.
- 2. A scheme under s278, paid for by Epping Forest DC, has recently been completed at this location, which has eased congestion. The proposal will reverse that gain.
- 3. Alternative methods of controlling the speed of vehicles exiting the M11 should be considered instead, including effective rumble strips, narrowing the exit, stop rather than give way signage, speed limits on the off slip, etc
